Board Talk

Snow Removal – When there’s a major snow storm like last month’s, the plowing company starts working during the storm to maintain access to the community for emergency vehicles. When the storm ends, plowing continues in order to clear the roads completely and to enable mail delivery. When needed, the roads are salted to remove ice. Sometimes, the plows will return the day after the storm to remove drifts and re-salt bad spots. During a major storm the roads are plowed multiple times and every time this is done, some snow from the road may be pushed into private driveways. We understand the difficulty this may cause you, but it is unavoidable, as we have to clear the road. If you are unable to clear the drive yourself, you may want to arrange with a private contractor to have your drive cleared after the storm. There is a list of local companies on the Wolfe Pointe web site. Also, during storms, we’ll post updates on snow removal status on the web page.

Yard Waste Disposal – As of January 1, 2011, it is no longer legal to put yard waste into your regular trash pick-up. We are looking into what we might do to help with your yard waste disposal and we will be updating the community web site: www.WolfePointe.com with information on options for yard waste disposal. That should be available next month, so watch for it online.

Christmas Tree Removal

We’ve had complaints about residents disposing of their Christmas trees on vacant lots or behind the pump stations. This is not the appropriate way to dispose of Christmas trees. The best way to dispose of Christmas trees is to take them to Cape Henlopen State Park where they will be recycled for free. Please keep this in mind when you are disposing of your tree next year. This is good for your neighbors and good for the environment.
