

Additional Comments from 5/28/14 Meeting with Chesapeake Utilities

Everyone should review the map of the route for the main gas lines. This map can be found on our web site, www.wolfepointe.com. If you live on the side of the street that the gas main will run on, you will need to mark your irrigation heads when they run the gas mains throughout the community. **THIS APPLIES TO EVERYONE, EVEN IF YOU ARE NOT GOING TO HOOK UP TO THE NATURAL GAS.**

The tentative schedule is to start work on our gas mains on about 9/22. When you see white flags popping up around the community, they will indicate where they will be running the gas mains. As soon as you see these flags, you will need to mark your irrigation heads so they are not disturbed. If you are going to have your irrigation lines blown out and shut down for the season before you see the white flags, you should **mark your irrigation heads before you shut your system down so they can be found when it comes time to run the mains and hook up to the gas.** You can either get small orange flags, or you can use marking paint which lasts up to a month and can be reapplied if it is fading. Both the flags and the marking paint are available at any local home building supply or hardware store

If you are planning to hook up to natural gas, you should talk to your propane supplier now to see what you need to do. You should also probably take your deliveries off of **Auto Fill**, and change it to **Will Call** and keep an eye on your propane level.

If you have not yet signed an application for natural gas, you can still hook up at any time in the future. However, during this initial hook up period, there will not be any additional charge if the line from the main to your meter is more than 75 feet. But pay close attention to the map showing the location of the main lines. If your home is on the opposite side of the street from the main, there is a good chance they will need to run the hook up line more than 75 feet, and you will have to pay an additional fee if you do not do this in the initial hook up period.
