Roads and Grounds – Roads & Grounds will be inspecting ditches and swales this month. If you see someone in a brightly colored vest or jacket walking an outfall swale, it is a Roads and Grounds committee person evaluating the need for maintenance. Our ditches and swales are a critical component of our stormwater management system. Keeping them clear, stabilized and functioning is critical for conveyance and meeting water quality and quantity control requirements. Please keep leaves and debris out of ditches and inspect driveway culverts for hidden blockages. Standing water in a ditch is okay for a day or so, but if it is there for more than three (3) days there may be other issues. Our soils are permeable and water generally infiltrates into the ground. If you think you have an issue, please send R&G an email (rjkeller3@comcast.net). Please help us maintain the snow stakes around our roadways. Stakes were placed the first week of January and our snow removal contractor requires them as part of our agreement. If you see a stake that has been knocked down, please put it back if you are able or contact RJ Keller at R&G (rjkeller3@comcast.net) and we will see that it is replaced. Use care when handling a snow stake as they are made of fiberglass and may give off splinters that can be painful. Don't let children play with them. If you choose to put out additional stakes along your property frontage, just keep track of the ones that belong to you.
