From Roads and Grounds - As we come to the end of "leaf" season, please inspect your driveway culverts for debris and sediment. Leaves and buildup can block water flow and cause flooding. If needed, have your culverts cleaned and regraded to ensure proper drainage. Also, do not plant trees or shrubs in roadside ditches or outfall swales. These areas are vital to our stormwater management system and must remain clear and functional.

With earlier sunsets and dusk falling around 5 pm, visibility on our roadways is reduced. If you're walking or biking on our roads or pathways, please wear light-colored or reflective clothing and carry a flashlight so motorists can see you.
