Roads & Grounds - A quick reminder as we head into fall: please avoid dumping grass clippings in our Open Space areas. We've noticed some buildup around the evergreen trees near the tennis court parking lot, and unfortunately, it's stressing the trees and screen plantings—some branches are even showing signs of dieback. Our landscape contractor is aware and keeping an eye on it.

If your lawn service collects clippings, please make sure they're hauling them away. It helps keep our shared spaces healthy and looking great.

On a positive note, we recently completed

inspections of all our outfall swales, and most are in great shape! These swales play a key role in our stormwater system, helping prevent ponding and drainage issues. A few areas will need cleanup soon, and we'll let nearby homeowners know when contractors are scheduled.

One last thing: please remind your contractors to keep vehicles and equipment on paved surfaces. Our roadside ditches are sensitive to heavy machinery, and staying on the pavement helps protect irrigation heads, preserve our landscaping, and avoid grading problems.
